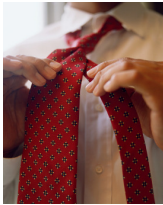

Susi attempted to kill herself!

Her mom blamed herself and felt that she had failed as a parent. The counselor at Concord met with Susi and her parents. She gave them information about learning disabilities. They talked about possible ways Susi could lessen her stress level at school and ways her family could help at home.

Susi started applying some of the techniques. Her mood and confidence improved. She started telling her friends she needed to focus on herself and began to set limits with them.

When her mom saw the improvement in her daughter’s life, she stopped blaming herself for her daughter’s suicide attempt.

Susi and her family have discovered that they have inner strengths that can help them overcome the challenges she will face.
